- Drive the LDC program through all implementation phases in the respective functional area with the given expertise
- Ensure justified local requirements (LSTRs – Legal, Statutory, Tax, and Regulatory) and required local integrations are appropriately assessed and incorporated into the solution delivered to the country
- Establish a strong connection with the local stakeholders and teams from engagement phase until handover to business as usual
- Establish and run effective country-level governance structures, including: Transparent status reporting (KIPs, milestones, progress vs. plan), Proactive risk and issues management, and Effective escalation and decision-making mechanisms
- Support country lead in identifying risks and issues along the implementation lifecycle
- Support change management excellence by preparing the organization for change to ensure ultimate in-country buy in & support of LDC as a global solution
