- Consolidate and validate data from multiple sources, including online booking tools, expense systems, travel management companies, and supplier reports.
- Support supplier management by evaluating airline, hotel, car, and agency performance against contractual commitments and service levels.
- Provide analytical support for sourcing initiatives, negotiations, benchmarking, audits, and business reviews. Identify root causes of traveler friction and process inefficiencies, and recommend improvements to policy, reporting, or system configuration.
- Prepare executive-ready insights and presentations for leadership, highlighting risks, opportunities, and recommended actions. Partner with stakeholders across Travel, Procurement, Finance, and P&O to align reporting with business priorities.
- Ensure data accuracy, governance, and documentation standards are maintained across all analytics processes.

- 2–5+ years of experience in analytics, procurement, finance, business operations, or corporate travel program management.

- Experience working with travel, expense, ERP, or supplier data sources.
- Ability to communicate complex data clearly to both technical and non-technical audiences.
