Responsibilities:

- Own and maintain the product backlog, prioritizing features and user stories based on business value and strategic objectives.
- Collaborate with business stakeholders to gather requirements, define acceptance criteria, and translate needs into actionable product specifications.
- Work closely with Engineering, Applied AI, UX, Data Science, and Architecture teams to deliver AI-enabled capabilities on time and with high quality.
- Support product discovery, sprint planning, release management, user acceptance testing, and continuous improvement activities.
- Monitor product adoption, customer feedback, usage analytics, and key performance indicators to identify enhancement opportunities.
- Ensure product delivery aligns with enterprise architecture, governance, Responsible AI standards, and platform design principles.
- Facilitate communication across cross-functional teams and serve as the day-to-day product owner for assigned product domains.
